

2019 RIVERVIEW MATCH PLAY INFORMATION SHEET

Overview - For those that may not be familiar to match play, scoring happens on a hole-by-hole basis (rather than the cumulative total in stroke play) – Even if a player loses a hole by four strokes, they have only lost that one hole. A player wins a match when they lead by more holes than remain to be played.

Concessions – A player can concede an opponent’s next stroke (or even a hole or the entire match) at any time.

Handicaps – Handicaps will be based on the RCGA system or as approved at 75% of a players handicap and then “zeroed down” for the match. For example;

Player A: Handicap from yellow tees = 10
 Player B: Handicap from white tees =5

Player A: Handicap for this event is (10 x 75% = 7.5 which is rounded to 8)
 Player B: Handicap for this event is (5 x 75% = 3.75 which is rounded to 4)

Thus to **zero down**: Player A (8) - Player B (4) = 4 net strokes

Player A would receive one stroke on the 4 toughest holes based on the Handicap on the scorecard:

Holes 1 & 7 on the Front Nine, Holes 11 & 18 on the Back Nine

If Player A was playing from the Red Tees (female golfer) the handicap would be determined from those tees and the strokes would be on the following holes:

Holes: 1 & 5 on the Front Nine, Holes 12 & 13 on the Back Nine.

******As always, please do not hesitate to ask for help if needed.******

Information:

1. Please ensure every effort is made to play your match before the deadline outlined on the bracket at the top of each match. Contact information can be found in the Pro Shop. If one player is more available than the other, and the match is unable to be played, by mutual agreement, the person that is most available should win the match. If both players using best efforts are not able to play the match a coin flip should determine the match at the deadline to enable the tournament to continue.
2. Women will play from the Red Tee's. All Seniors (50+) will play from the Yellow Tee's. All other players will play from the White Tee's. Each player's handicap will be based off the respective tee being played.
3. In the interest of pace of play, if at anytime a player has taken more strokes than would be reasonably possible to win the hole, the hole can and should be conceded to the opponent.
4. At any time an opponent can concede a putt, however the **opponent must concede the putt**, if it is not conceded it must be holed.
5. The match is not over until one player has won more holes than his/her opponent is able to win. In the event the match is tied after 18 holes, please continue from hole 1 and play sudden death until the match is decided, the same holes that an opponent received strokes applies. using the same holes for strokes as during the first 18 holes is the same in sudden death.
6. Please ensure the Match Play results sheet is completed and turned into the Pro Shop at the conclusion of your round to enable efficient updates to the schedule.
7. The deadline for playing matches is only a deadline, thus if you are able to play a match well before please do so.
8. In the event of a dispute, please play an additional ball for that hole and get a ruling after the match.
